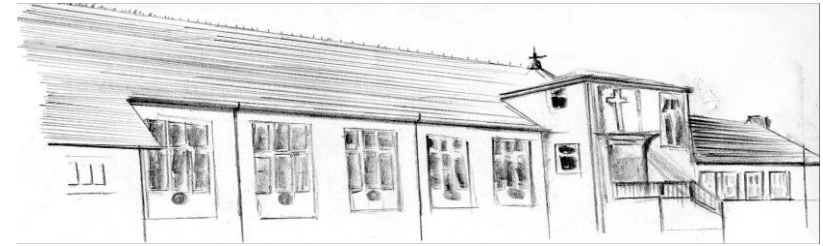
S.V.P. The next meeting of the St. Vincent de Paul Society will take Place in the parish hall at **7.35pm on Tuesday 30th Jan 2018.**
